



Powerball Fact Sheet – Wednesday, Aug. 27 Drawing

Current Estimated Jackpot: \$815 million
\$367.9 million cash value

- National ticket sales have doubled in the last week, with a 100.93% increase in ticket sales for the Aug. 25 Powerball drawing compared to the previous Monday drawing.
- This is the 7th largest Powerball jackpot and the game's biggest advertised jackpot in more than a year!

- Wednesday's drawing will be the 38th drawing, since the Powerball jackpot was last won in California on May 31, 2025. The game's longest jackpot streak stands at 42 consecutive drawings, which was set on April 6, 2024, with a \$1.326 billion jackpot winner in Oregon.
 - Four Powerball jackpots have been won, so far, this year:
 - Jan 18, 2025 - \$328.5 million – Oregon
 - Mar 29, 2025 - \$526.5 million – California
 - Apr 26, 2025 - \$167.3 million – Kentucky
 - May 31, 2025 - \$204.5 million – California

Jackpot Estimates and Game Odds

- Powerball jackpot winners may choose to receive their prize as an annuity or a lump-sum payment (cash option). Both advertised prize options are prior to federal and jurisdictional taxes.
- Both advertised prize options are *estimates* based on projected ticket sales and interest rates. Differences between the estimates and final amounts may occur based on final tickets sales.
- A jackpot winner who selects the annuity will receive one immediate payment followed by 29 annual payments that increase by 5% each year.
- *How is the jackpot estimate determined?* The two main factors that determine the advertised estimate (annuity option) are ticket sales and the annuity factor. The annuity factor, or cost to fund an annuity prize, is made up of interest rates for securities purchased to fund prize payments. Higher interest rates allow us to purchase a larger annuitized prize.
- How much of a Powerball ticket goes to the jackpot? 50% of a \$2 Powerball ticket goes to fund prizes. From that dollar, 68 cents go to the jackpot prize pool, the remaining 32 cents go to the lower-tier prize pool. Powerball has set cash prizes for lower-tier prize categories, because the number of lower-tier prizes awarded increases as sales increase.
- Players have the same odds in every Powerball drawing, regardless of the jackpot amount or how many tickets are sold for a particular drawing.
 - The overall odds of winning a prize are 1 in 24.9.
 - The odds of winning the jackpot are 1 in 292.2 million.
 - The current Powerball game matrix and odds have not changed since 2015.

About Powerball®

Powerball® holds the current world record for largest national lottery jackpot at \$2.04 billion. Since its first drawing in 1992, the game has helped generate more than \$36 billion for good causes supported by U.S. lotteries. More than half of all proceeds from the sale of a Powerball ticket remain in the jurisdiction where the ticket was sold. Powerball tickets are \$2 per play. Tickets are sold in 45 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. Powerball drawings are broadcast live every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday at 10:59 p.m. ET from the Florida Lottery draw studio in Tallahassee.
