

National Mega Millions Fast Facts for the Friday, Jan. 13, 2023 drawing

- The estimated annuity jackpot for the Tuesday, Jan. 10 drawing is \$1.35 billion, with an estimated cash value of \$707.9 million. It is the 2nd highest Mega Millions jackpot to date.
- Last Mega Millions jackpot hit: \$502 million (\$252.0 million cash) Oct. 14 in Florida and California.
- The last Mega Millions drawing on Jan. 10 produced 6,154,167 winning tickets, including:
 - <u>16</u> second-tier winners of \$1 million or more. (California, Florida, Kansas, Massachusetts (2),
 Missouri, New Jersey, New York, Ohio (2), Oregon, Pennsylvania, West Virginia; and 3x winners:
 Connecticut, Florida, New York)
 - o 215 third-tier winners of at least \$10,000
 - (41 of the 215 winners won with the 3x Megaplier for \$30,000.)
- In the 25 drawings since the last jackpot hit (October 18 draw through January 10), there have been:
 - 68 second-tier winning tickets of at least \$1 million* (13 of the 68 with the Megaplier)
 - o **920** third-tier winning tickets of at least \$10,000* (157 of the 920 with the Megaplier)

With a total of 33,271,792 winning tickets across all nine prize tiers

- * Prizes in California paid on a pari-mutuel basis and differ from fixed prize amounts
- Estimated annuity and cash values are announced prior to drawing dates and are based on projected sales. Differences between the estimates and final amounts may occur because a substantial percentage of sales happen on the drawing date. The cash value is the amount of cash in the jackpot pool. If a winner chooses the annuity, the cash value is used to buy bonds that fund the annual payments.

National Mega Millions Fast Facts for the Friday, Jan. 13, 2023 drawing

- The largest Mega Millions jackpot was \$1.537 billion on October 23, 2018, with one winning ticket sold in South Carolina. The winner claimed anonymously. It is now the third-largest jackpot in U.S. lottery history, trailing the \$2.040 billion Powerball jackpot on Nov. 7, 2022, and the \$1.586 billion Powerball jackpot on Jan. 13, 2016.

- Mega Millions tickets are sold in 47 jurisdictions: 45 states; Washington, D.C., and the U.S. Virgin Islands.
- Tickets are \$2; The Megaplier option is an additional \$1. Prizes on all Megaplier tickets are multiplied, except for the jackpot.
- Drawings are conducted at 11 p.m. Eastern Time on Tuesdays and Fridays in Atlanta, Georgia.
- The starting jackpot for the next drawing after a jackpot-winning Mega Millions ticket is sold is currently \$20 million but can vary depending on game sales and interest rates. There is no fixed minimum jackpot roll increase, which also is dependent on game sales and interest rates.
- A jackpot winner who opts for the annuity receives one immediate payment and annual payments that increase by 5% per year for 29 years.
- The "Just the Jackpot" wager type costs \$3 and gives players two Quick Pick entries for a chance to win the jackpot only. Just the Jackpot is not available in all jurisdictions.
- Overall chances of winning any prize: 1 in 24. Odds of winning the jackpot: 1 in 303 million.
- How to Play: Players select five numbers from 1 to 70 and one Mega Ball number from 1 to 25. There are
 nine prize tiers, ranging from \$2 to the jackpot.
- Mega Millions originally launched as "The Big Game," with its first drawing on Sept. 6, 1996. Its name was changed to Mega Millions in 2002.
- The first Mega Millions drawing was held on May 17, 2002 and produced a \$28 million jackpot winner from Illinois.
- Beneficiaries: Lottery profits support a wide variety of good causes and are allocated differently in each jurisdiction.
