

National Mega Millions Fast Facts for the Tuesday, Aug. 8 drawing

- The estimated annuity jackpot for the Tuesday, Aug. 8 drawing is <u>\$1.58 billion</u>, with an estimated cash value of <u>\$783.3 million</u>.
- Last Mega Millions jackpot hit: \$20 million (\$10.5 million cash) April 18 in New York.
- The last Mega Millions drawing on Friday, Aug. 4, produced 5,331,114 winning tickets, including:
 - <u>Nine</u> second-tier winners of \$1 million or more: Louisiana, Michigan (2x), Missouri, Nebraska, New York, Oklahoma, Tennessee (2 w/one 2x), and Texas
 - 128 third-tier winners of at least \$10,000
 - (24 of the 128 winners included the 2x Megaplier for \$20,000.)
- In the 31 drawings since the last jackpot hit (April 21 draw through Aug. 4), there have been:
 - o 62 second-tier winning tickets of at least \$1 million* (11 of the 62 with the Megaplier)
 - **<u>967</u>** third-tier winning tickets of at least \$10,000* (182 of the 967 with the Megaplier)

With a total of 36,644,468 million winning tickets across all nine prize tiers.

* Prizes in California paid on a pari-mutuel basis and differ from fixed prize amounts

• Estimated annuity and cash values are announced prior to drawing dates and are based on projected sales. Differences between the estimates and final amounts may occur because a substantial percentage of sales happen on the drawing date. The cash value is the amount of cash in the jackpot pool. If a winner chooses the annuity, the cash value is used to buy bonds that fund the annual payments.

National Mega Millions Fast Facts for the Tuesday, Aug. 8, 2023 drawing

- The largest Mega Millions jackpot is the estimated \$1.58 billion jackpot for August 8, 2023. It is now the third-largest jackpot in U.S. lottery history, trailing the \$2.040 billion Powerball jackpot on Nov. 7, 2022, and the \$1.586 billion Powerball jackpot on Jan. 13, 2016.

- Mega Millions tickets are sold in 47 jurisdictions: 45 states; Washington, D.C., and the U.S. Virgin Islands.
- Tickets are \$2; The Megaplier option is an additional \$1. Prizes on all Megaplier tickets are multiplied, except for the jackpot.
- Drawings are conducted at 11 p.m. Eastern Time on Tuesdays and Fridays in Atlanta, Georgia.
- The starting jackpot for the next drawing after a jackpot-winning Mega Millions ticket is sold is currently \$20 million but can vary depending on game sales and interest rates. There is no fixed minimum jackpot roll increase, which also is dependent on game sales and interest rates.
- A jackpot winner who opts for the annuity receives one immediate payment and annual payments that increase by 5% per year for 29 years.
- The "Just the Jackpot" wager type costs \$3 and gives players two Quick Pick entries for a chance to win the jackpot only. Just the Jackpot is not available in all jurisdictions.
- Overall chances of winning any prize: 1 in 24. Odds of winning the jackpot: 1 in 303 million.
- How to Play: Players select five numbers from 1 to 70 and one Mega Ball number from 1 to 25. There are <u>nine prize tiers</u>, ranging from \$2 to the jackpot.
- Mega Millions originally launched as "The Big Game," with its first drawing on Sept. 6, 1996. Its name was changed to Mega Millions in 2002.
- The first Mega Millions drawing was held on May 17, 2002, and produced a \$28 million jackpot winner from Illinois.
- Beneficiaries: Lottery profits support a wide variety of good causes and are allocated differently in each jurisdiction.
