- The estimated annuity jackpot for the Tuesday, Aug. 8 drawing is $\$ 1.58$ billion, with an estimated cash value of $\$ 783.3$ million.
- Last Mega Millions jackpot hit: $\$ 20$ million ( $\$ 10.5$ million cash) April 18 in New York.
- The last Mega Millions drawing on Friday, Aug. 4, produced $5,331,114$ winning tickets, including:
- Nine second-tier winners of $\$ 1$ million or more: Louisiana, Michigan (2x), Missouri, Nebraska, New York, Oklahoma, Tennessee ( $2 \mathrm{w} /$ one 2 x ), and Texas
- 128 third-tier winners of at least $\$ 10,000$
- (24 of the 128 winners included the $2 x$ Megaplier for $\$ 20,000$.)
- In the 31 drawings since the last jackpot hit (April 21 draw through Aug. 4), there have been:
- $\underline{\mathbf{6 2}}$ second-tier winning tickets of at least $\$ 1$ million* (11 of the 62 with the Megaplier)
- $\underline{967}$ third-tier winning tickets of at least \$10,000* (182 of the 967 with the Megaplier)

With a total of $\mathbf{3 6}, \mathbf{6 4 4}, 468$ million winning tickets across all nine prize tiers.

* Prizes in California paid on a pari-mutuel basis and differ from fixed prize amounts
- Estimated annuity and cash values are announced prior to drawing dates and are based on projected sales. Differences between the estimates and final amounts may occur because a substantial percentage of sales happen on the drawing date. The cash value is the amount of cash in the jackpot pool. If a winner chooses the annuity, the cash value is used to buy bonds that fund the annual payments.

## National Mega Millions Fast Facts for the Tuesday, Aug. 8, 2023 drawing

- The largest Mega Millions jackpot is the estimated $\$ 1.58$ billion jackpot for August 8 , 2023. It is now the third-largest jackpot in U.S. lottery history, trailing the $\$ 2.040$ billion Powerball jackpot on Nov. 7, 2022, and the $\$ 1.586$ billion Powerball jackpot on Jan. 13, 2016.

- Mega Millions tickets are sold in 47 jurisdictions: 45 states; Washington, D.C., and the U.S. Virgin Islands.
- Tickets are \$2; The Megaplier option is an additional \$1. Prizes on all Megaplier tickets are multiplied, except for the jackpot.
- Drawings are conducted at 11 p.m. Eastern Time on Tuesdays and Fridays in Atlanta, Georgia.
- The starting jackpot for the next drawing after a jackpot-winning Mega Millions ticket is sold is currently $\$ 20$ million but can vary depending on game sales and interest rates. There is no fixed minimum jackpot roll increase, which also is dependent on game sales and interest rates.
- A jackpot winner who opts for the annuity receives one immediate payment and annual payments that increase by $5 \%$ per year for 29 years.
- The "Just the Jackpot" wager type costs $\$ 3$ and gives players two Quick Pick entries for a chance to win the jackpot only. Just the Jackpot is not available in all jurisdictions.
- Overall chances of winning any prize: 1 in 24 . Odds of winning the jackpot: 1 in 303 million.
- How to Play: Players select five numbers from 1 to 70 and one Mega Ball number from 1 to 25 . There are nine prize tiers, ranging from $\$ 2$ to the jackpot.
- Mega Millions originally launched as "The Big Game," with its first drawing on Sept. 6, 1996. Its name was changed to Mega Millions in 2002.
- The first Mega Millions drawing was held on May 17, 2002, and produced a $\$ 28$ million jackpot winner from Illinois.
- Beneficiaries: Lottery profits support a wide variety of good causes and are allocated differently in each jurisdiction.
